

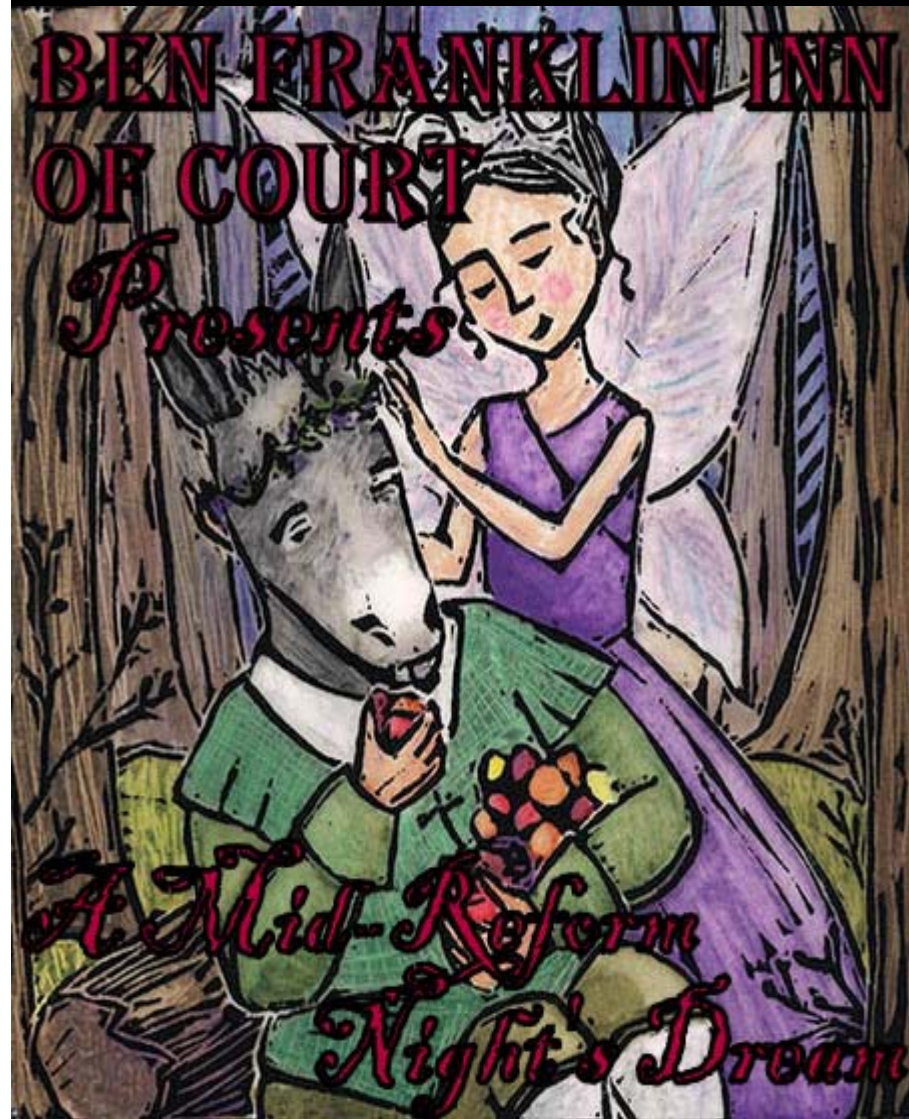

**Act I: Bottom visits Patent Attorney,
Titania**

Scene I: Office in a wood near Athens

**Scene 2: Bottom and Titania are in
the office of Examiner, Puck**

**Act II: Fairy Patent and Trademark Office
(FPTO)**

April 1, 1613: Bottom invents new saddle and
bridle

April 15, 1613: Bottom publicly discloses both
inventions at a play where Mustardseed was
present

April 20, 1613: Mustardseed files patent
application in the UK

June 15, 1613: Mustardseed's UK application
publishes early (Not discovered until later in
meeting)

July 15, 1613: Bottom files patent application in
the US

August 15, 1613: Mustardseed files US
application referencing UK application

Today, November 9, 1613: Bottom and Titania
meet with the FPTO

**Act III: Quarters of Examiner, Puck at the
Patent and Trademark Office**

August 15, 1612: Shakespeare Inc. makes first
sale.

December 15, 1612: Shakespeare Inc. informs
Mexican branch of the invention.

April 1, 1613: Bottom conceives and reduces to
practice his invention.

July 15, 1613: Bottom files his patent application
in the US.
