ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Donald Crandlemire, a Maine native, was a 1993 graduate of the Franklin Pierce Law Center (now UNH School of Law) where he met his wife, Jennifer Frizzel, also a 1993 graduate. Over the course of his career, Don worked for small and large firms as well as serving as in-house counsel at a major NH hospital. He was cross-trained professional with an educational background in engineering and a master's degree in business administration. Don was an advisor to businesses, healthcare organizations and non-profits. He loved the outdoors and cherished his family. Don also cherished the fellowship of other attorneys. He gave himself freely as an advisor to peers and a mentor to junior attorneys. His joy for the fellowship of his colleagues extended into his role and commitment to our Inn of Court. The following eligibility criteria have been adopted for the Crandlemire Inn of Court Scholarship:

- **An attorney who has been practicing for less than five (5) years.**
- **A graduate of University of New Hampshire School of Law.**
- **An attorney who intends to have a long career in New Hampshire.**
- **An attorney who values collegial relationships within the Inn, Bar, County, or Women's Bar Associations.**
- **Special consideration will be given to those attorneys from Maine.**
- **Special consideration will be given to those who practice in a small firm.**
- **Special consideration will be given to those attorneys who are a cross-trained in fields other than law.**
