Goals for mentoring/shadowing _____

Rules: Mentees are encouraged to attend the new member orientation. Mentors and mentees must strive to meet about once a month (and this can be before the Inns meeting). Mentors and mentees shall discuss practice related issues, but not any specific ongoing cases. Neither will have any responsibility for the other's cases! Mentors will not provide legal advice. The mentor/mentee relationship will last one year, and will extend beyond the eight month Inns' calendar. Judges will not be regular mentors and will not have regular meetings with mentees, but judges can be shadowed for a single day. Judges will not provide legal advice.
