



- Social distancing guidelines, school closures, etc. have produced barriers to disclosure and reporting of DV, child and elder abuse, and neglect
- Travel restrictions impact victims' escape or safety plans
- Limited access or fear of COVID prevents victims from filing for protective orders, legal assistance

DISCUSSION: REMOTE ACCESS AND JUSTICE

- Defendants whose bail hearings were remote had increases in bond amounts ranging from 54% - 90% compared to in-person counterparts (Pre-COVID studies)
- Studies of remote witness testimony found that children were perceived as less accurate, believable, consistent, confident when appearing by video
- Study of immigration courts found that detained individuals more likely to be deported when hearings occur over video
- Credibility assessments made during video proceedings may be deemed less reliable in subsequent proceedings




