



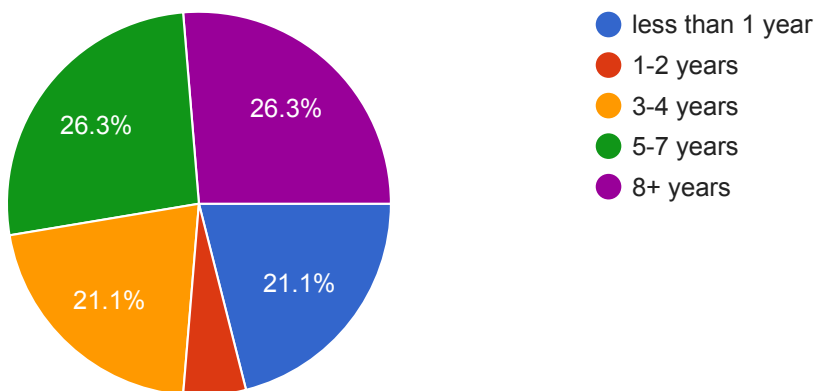

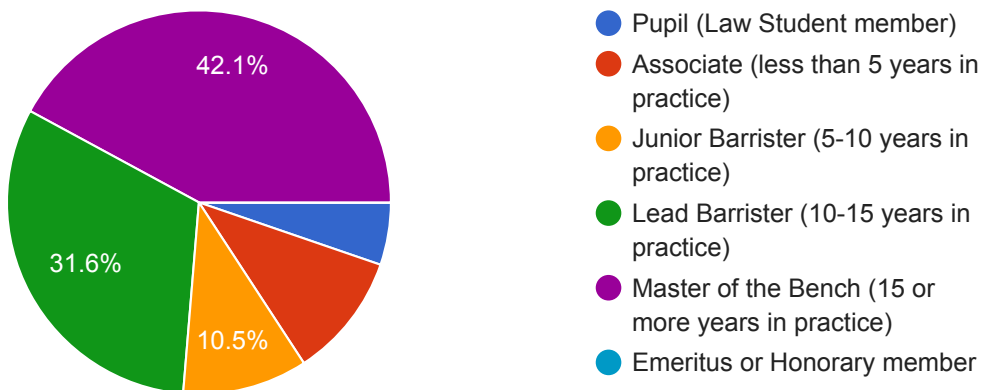
How long have you been a member of WVAIC?

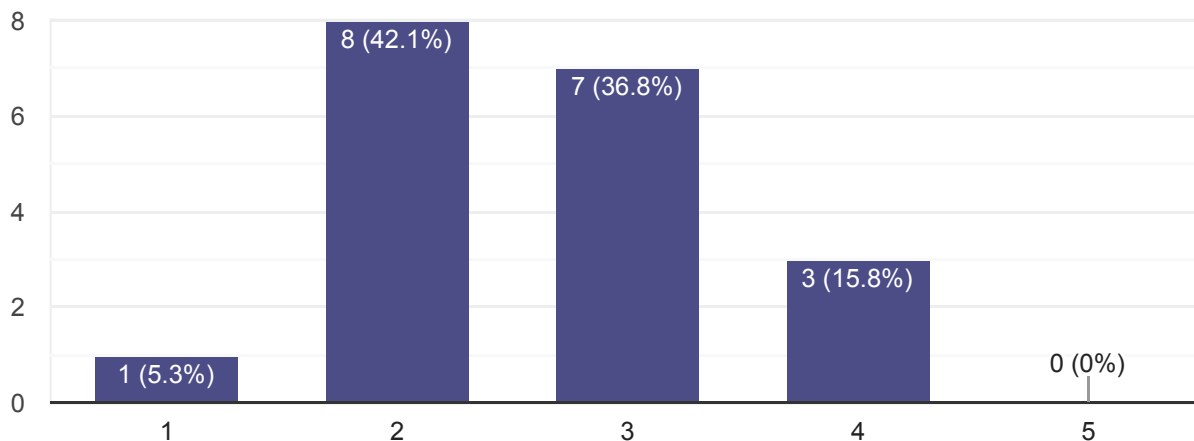

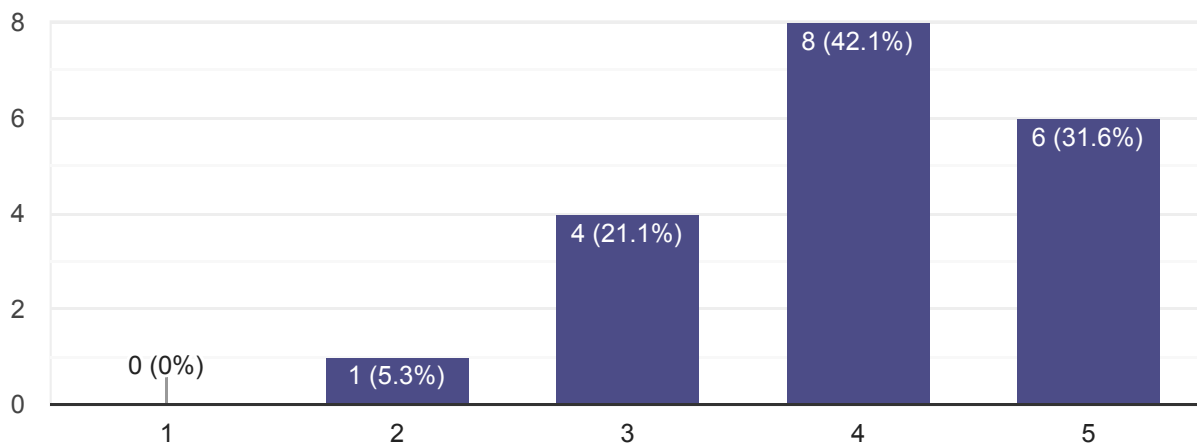
The number of members in the Inn is about right.

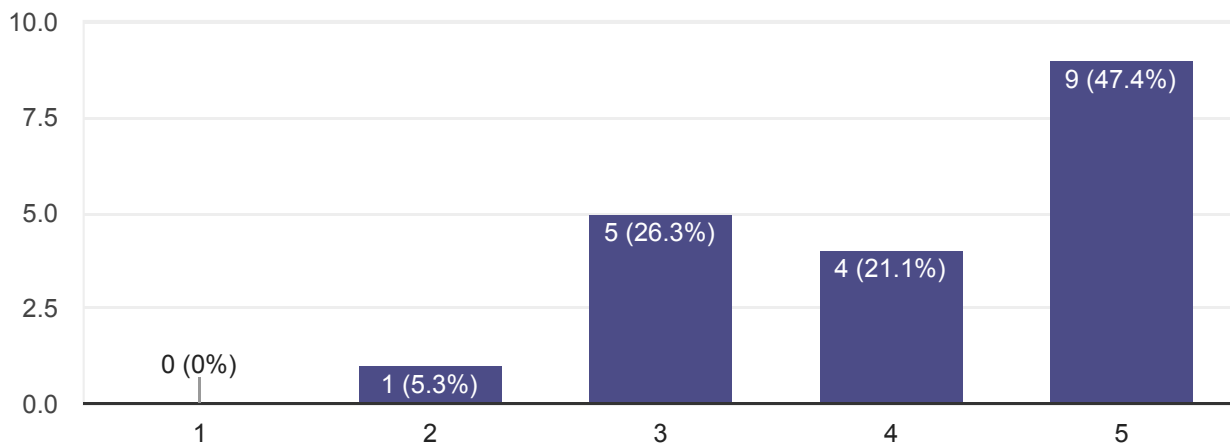

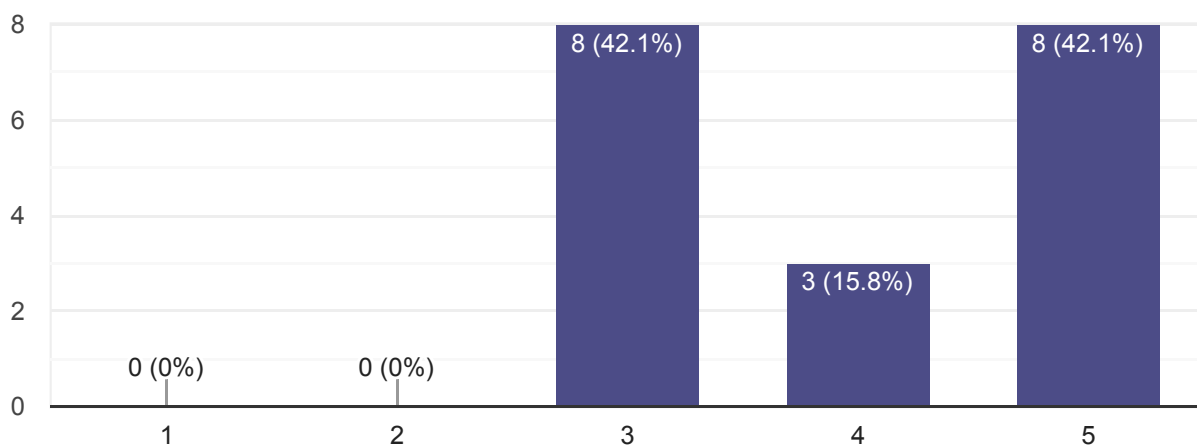
The executive committee provides strong leadership.

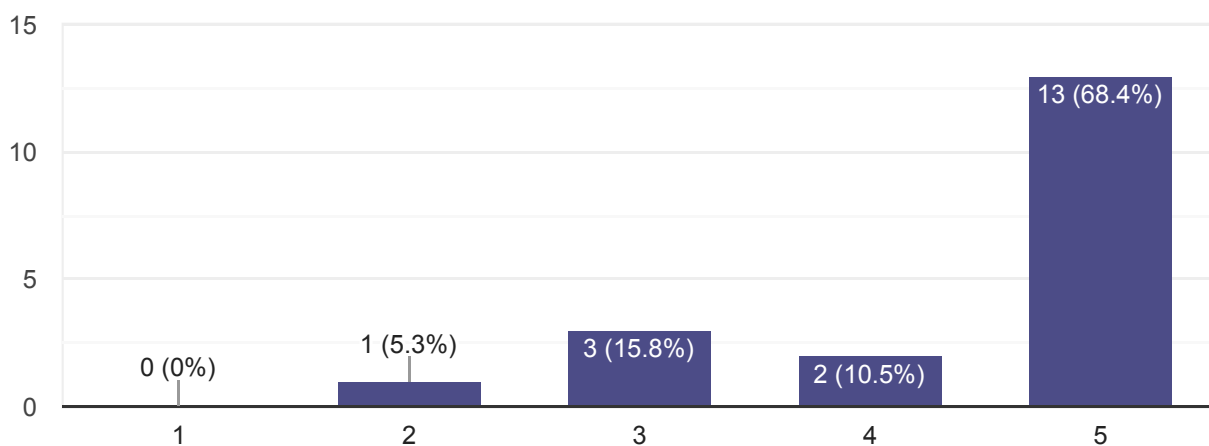

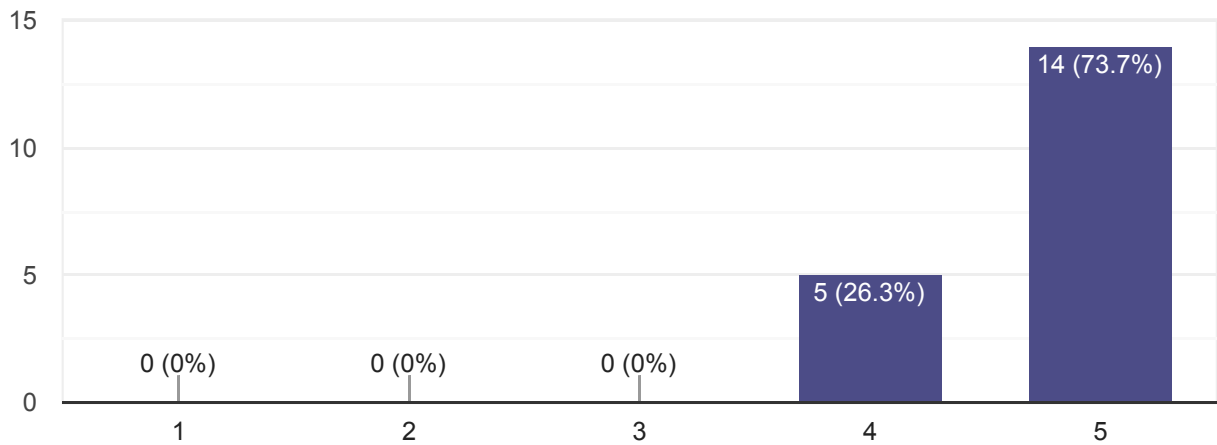

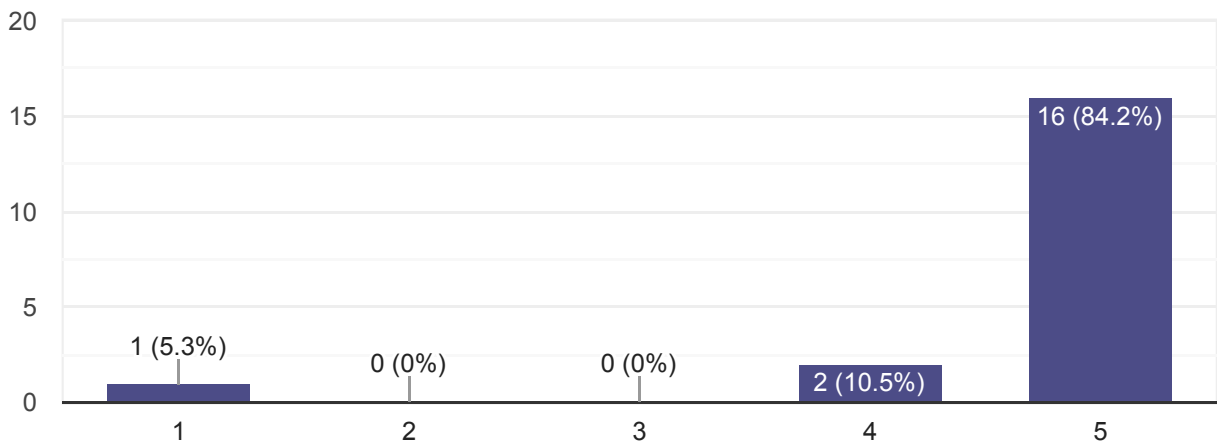
I know when our meetings are held.

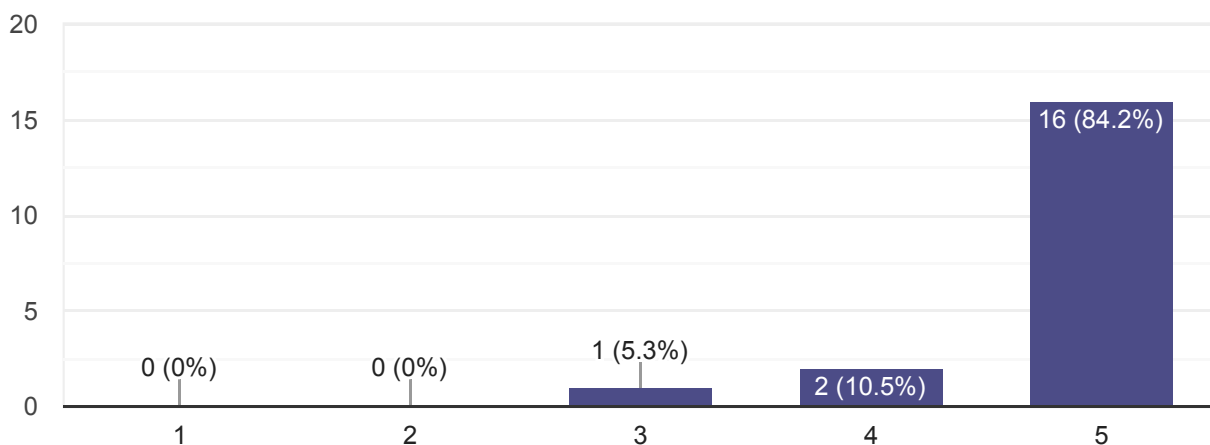

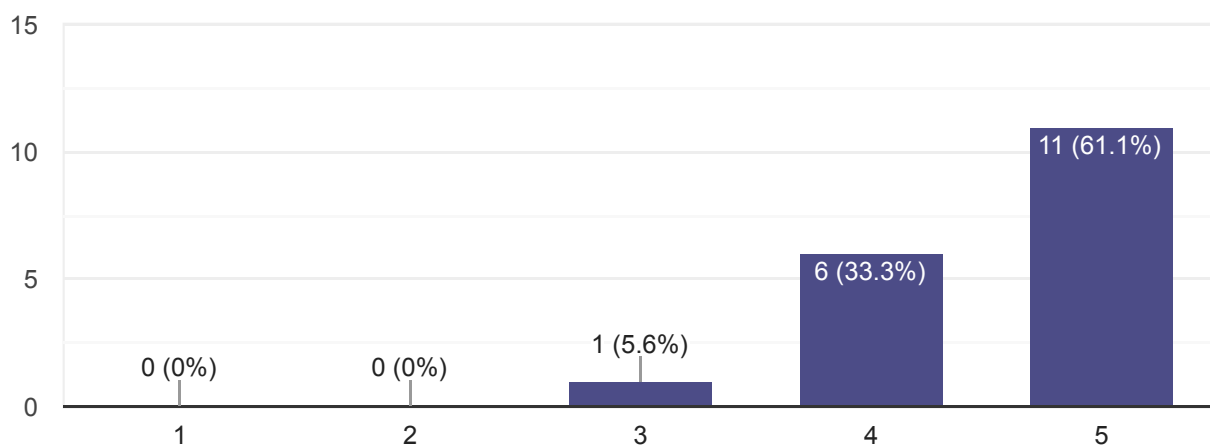

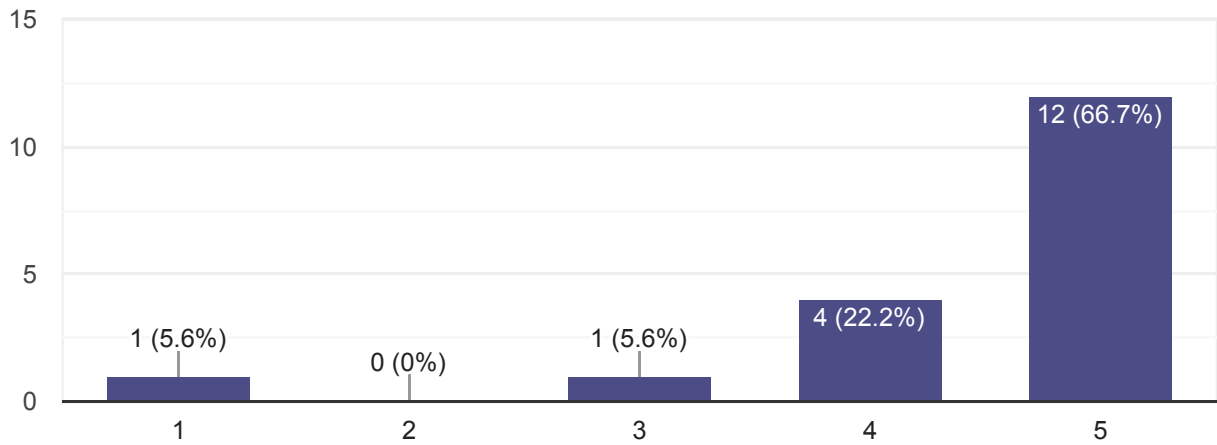

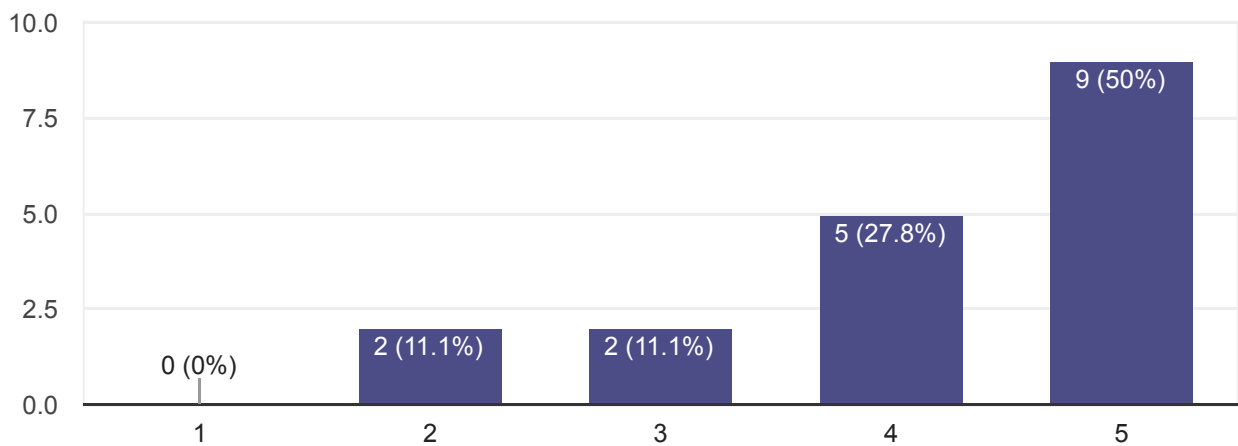

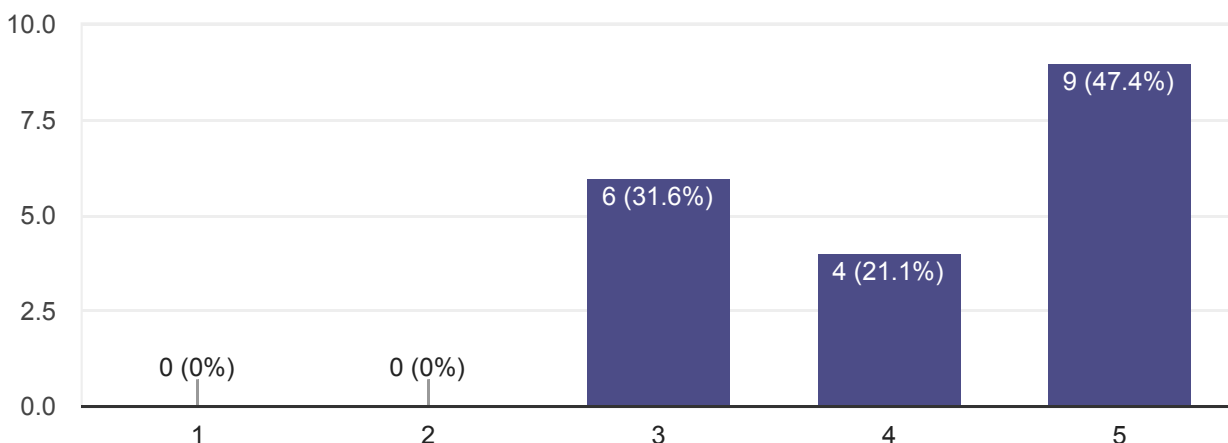
The balance of program topics is about right.

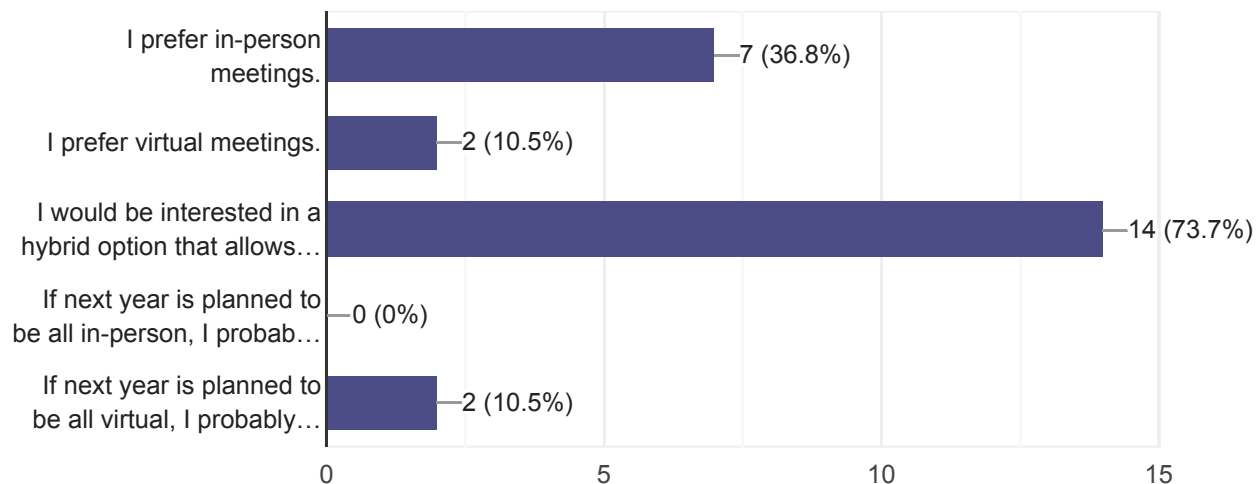

Meeting format (in-person, virtual, hybrid)

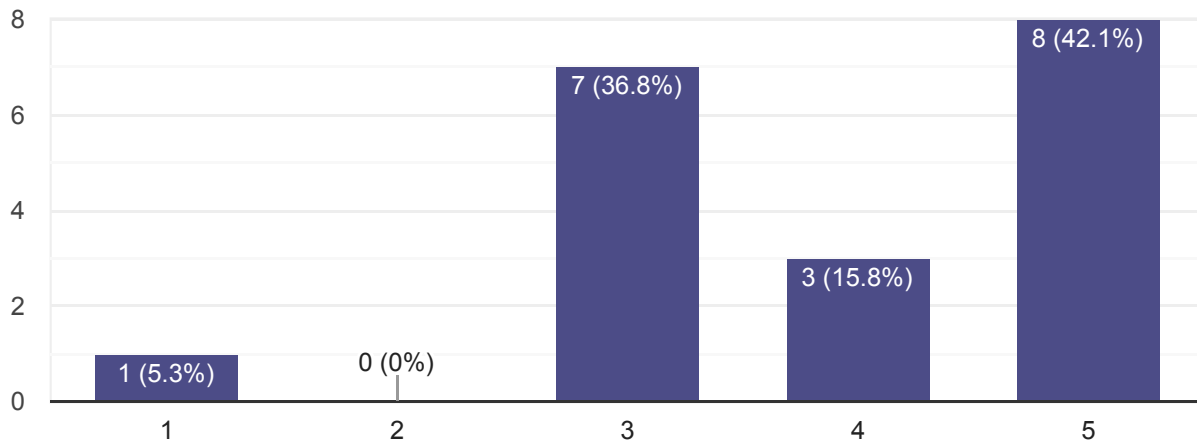

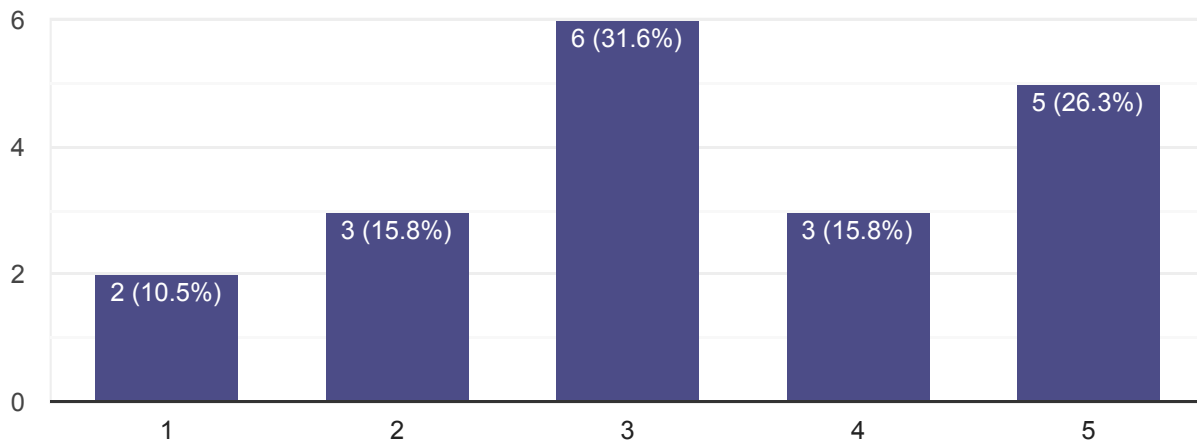
I believe the Inn promotes and provides opportunities for informal or casual mentoring.
