The St. Thomas More Inn of Court originated at Loyola University New Orleans College of Law and is a member of the American Inns of Court. Among the objectives of the Inn are to promote excellence, civility, professionalism, and ethics in the legal profession. Experiences in the Inn will foster mentoring relationships among members, improve and enhance the skills of its members, promote interaction and collegiality among members, and help to transmit ethical values from one professional generation to another.

The Inn meets seven times a year: three times in the fall; four times in the spring, with the last meeting reserved for the Masters of the Inn. Each member of the Inn is assigned to a POD group, which collaboratively presents a one-hour educational CLE program to the Inn. Members are expected to help their POD group prepare the program and to attend CLE programs presented by the other PODs.

Dues range from \$50 per year for law students to \$325 for Masters, subject to occasional increases. Dues include the ability to earn four hours of CLE, which includes one hour each of ethics and professionalism, and delicious catered food and beverage at each meeting. Dues are also used to provide scholarships to members to attend out-of-state advocacy training and to support non-profit organizations within the metro New Orleans area.
