

STEP 6: LOOK UP THE BILL NUMBER TO LEARN MORE (IF THE BILL NUMBER IS AVAILABLE YET)



 On the front page, you can type into the search bar a bill number and enter to search information about it

STEP 7: CONFIRM THE BILL AND CLICK ON IT

AN ACT camping fees for non-residents.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Paragraph; Fees for Park System; Camping Fees for Non-residents. Amend RSA 216-
- 2 A:3-g by inserting after paragraph VIII the following new paragraph:
- IX. The commissioner may adopt a separate fee schedule for camping within the state park
 system for non-residents.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
