- Review your results – if you found something of interest, you can wait for the bill number to be added, so you can search the specific bill number on the front page of the General Court website to read a draft of the bill and learn more about its sponsor(s), upcoming hearings, etc. once the information is available

STEP 7: CONFIRM THE BILL AND CLICK ON IT

- On the next page, you can confirm that you have the correct bill title and number – this page will also indicate what chamber the bill is in, as well as its next/last hearing
- Click on the the bill number (to the left) to go to the bill's page, which will be updated with information as it travels through the legislative process

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Three

AN ACT camping fees for non-residents.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Fees for Park System; Camping Fees for Non-residents. Amend RSA 216-

2 A:3-g by inserting after paragraph VIII the following new paragraph:

3 IX. The commissioner may adopt a separate fee schedule for camping within the state park
4 system for non-residents.

5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
