VI. MEMBERSHIP COMMITMENT

Membership Commitment: The success of the Patrick E. Higginbotham American Inn of Court heavily depends on the active participation and commitment of our members. As a result, there are certain expectations of our members to ensure the effectiveness of our programs, activities, and mentoring opportunities.

To remain in good standing, members of the Inn are expected to:

1. Pay annual dues and any other expenses arising during the year within 30 days of receipt of an invoice for such expenses;
