The Bryan AIC continues its outreach by seeking new members who share the values embodied by the American Inns of Court.

Meetings and Membership

The Bryan AIC meets one Monday evening per month, September through May, both to share a meal and to hold programs and discussions on matters of ethics, skills and professionalism, with the goal of fostering more effective advocacy and a keener ethical awareness. Members who attend each of our regular programs also earn six WSBA-approved CLE credits per year. Our Members learn side-by-side with some of the most experienced judges and attorneys throughout our communities.

The meetings begin at 5:30 pm and include networking, a one-hour CLE, and a meal. Attendance at both the CLE and the meal meeting is required. Membership to the Bryan AIC is limited to no more than 80 active members. Because of this, we must adhere to a strict attendance policy where new members must attend at least 5 out of 6 of these meetings to remain in good standing. The Bryan AIC's meetings are held on a fully in-person basis.
