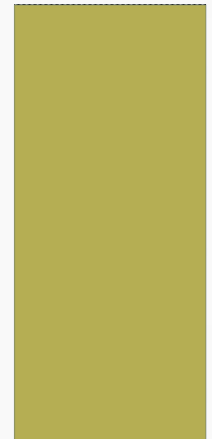

 - Changes to Proposed Rule 26(b)(1)
- Rules Committee to decide final form of Proposed Rules on April 10-11
